FALL AERATION OF YOUR GARDEN

Aeration is essential to maintaining a healthy lawn and garden. It allows roots and soil microorganisms to access a new supply of oxygen, while relieving compaction and promoting good humus formation and water absorption. Unlike a lawn, a garden cannot be aerated while the plants are in the soil. Aeration in a garden involves turning the soil, which means the soil must be moderately moist and that it crumbles in your hand when squeezed. If the soil forms one solid chunk when you squeeze it, it is still too wet and you must wait until it dries further. If it is rock-solid or crumbles to dust, it is too dry. In that case, water it well and then wait until it is moderately moist. Soil temperatures should also be moderate. Soil conditions are ideal in the fall. You should mix in fertilizers and soil amendments will help the soil to retain its structure. If your garden is well-maintained, it will not require tilling on a yearly basis; a thorough hoeing to 2-3 inches depth will suffice. Various garden tools and/or a rototiller may be used. Contact your local Garden Center for your soil amendments.
